It is already the 3rd time that the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg hosts this congress event and the organisation & coordination is guaranteed by the FHL, the national business association of gardeners & florists.

Other planned highlights in the congress programme are: the new infrastructures of the horticultural school of the "Lycée Technique Agricole" in Gilsdorf, the 'Awarded Garden of Excellence' rose garden of the "Château de Munsbach", the revitalisation of the industrial wastelands in Belval as well as many innovative family businesses from the floriculture, horticulture & viticulture sector. As well as many other 'Luxembourgish' horticultural features will enrich the diverse, unexpected, green CEJH Congress programme.


